Tub Liner , Truck Liner , 4x4 liner ,Truck Bed Liner , Ute Liner , Tray Liner , Hard Liner whatever the name they come in a number of guises. They may be Drop In, Rubber Mat, Spray On or Roll On. Dealer installed or D I Y . They all exist because there is a need to protect Utes , 4x4s , Trailers and Trucks from load damage.

The best tub liner is one that is sprayed or rolled permanently to the original body work, such as Herculiner, the USA’s market leading DIY brand, or dealer applied Line-X , Speedliner and Rhino Liner.

All of the drop in type bed liners damage the paint and wear metalwork as they vibrate and rub, worse still they allow the build up of dirt, moisture and corrosive spills under them and accelerate rust.

We had one installed in one of our off road vehicles and found it impossible to clean spills that leaked from it. When we removed it for inspection it was not a pretty sight.

They look OK but their hard construction provides a slippery surface and the contents slip and slide more than the standard finish.

Mats also collect moisture, slip and move about and most fail to protect the sides of your tub. We have tried mats and drop in liners in our off road vehicles, they simply don’t cut it when it comes to protection and reducing load movements.

That leaves three options, put up with the wear and tear, DIY liner materials or dealer applied liners.

You would not be reading this if you were happy to put up with the wear.

There are a large number of DIY liners available in the USA from cheap and nasty to the top of the line HERCULINER.

After searching all of the threads, chats and blogs we could find on this subject only one DIY was repeatedly recommended by users, HERCULINER.

No surprises why it is the market leader.

Myth

DIY linings are all inferior to Dealer applied linings.

Fact

The few negative comments on HERCULINER all originated from posts by users who had already shelled out their money on dealer applied coatings, ***none had actually used HERCULINER***, all were along the lines of ‘***...I had a buddy who knew a guy who used....***’ Some people just need to justify the big sums they have shelled out for dealer linings.

We could not find one negative comment from someone who had actually used HERCULINER, there were plenty from users of other DIY coatings and also users of dealer applied coatings.

Myth

Dealer applied coatings are superior to DIY coatings.

Fact

The websites of Rhino, Line-X and Speedliner etc will all tell you ‘*Ours is the best because ...*’

Obviously they can’t all be right and a close examination of independent data will lead you to believe all are similar.

Of course a Rhino or Speedliner dealer is going to tell you that their produce is superior to a DIY lining. How else could they justify the cost.

Check the specification comparison table to see there is little to choose between the physical strength of coatings.

Myth

Dealer applied coatings come with a warranty DIY do not.

Fact

One of the most common arguments in favour of dealer applied liners is they are more durable and covered by a warranty.

However none of the dealer applied coatings are warranted not to tear, rip or wear.

None are warranted for commercial use, Tradies forget it!

A read of the so called warranties clearly shows they are limited to guaranteeing that the liner has been correctly applied.

Rhino linings and others are not even warranted against hail stone damage – so don’t expect to your tools or a few bricks not to gouge and rip the liner!

Here are some of the critical exclusions from Rhino’s USA warranty displayed on their website.

Your Rhino Linings® sprayed-on truck bed liner, when applied to your vehicle’s original factory finish, is warranted to not crack, bubble or peel for as long as you own your vehicle. ***This warranty is applicable only to pickup trucks equipped with original equipment truck beds and original equipment paint, which are sold to individuals and are used solely for personal, noncommercial use.***

This warranty does not apply if your Rhino Linings® bed liner has been misused, abused, involved in an accident, ***gouged, dented, chipped***, intentionally pulled, removed as required by body work, subjected to stains or soils from chemicals such as paint strippers or solvents, or ***damaged due to natural causes such as hail*** or lightning. Additionally, this warranty ***does not cover natural sun fade on products.***

Lin-X warranty is similar to Rhinos.

Speedliner offer no warranty on their website.

Summary

All linings can be damaged by your load, no lining will last forever. All linings will fade over time if exposed to sunlight. No lining manufacturer warrants their product against damage due to wear and tear. We have no opinion about which dealer applied lining is the best – the big three all seem to satisfy their customers to varying degrees. HERCULINER is the only DIY liner we could find that matches the dealer applied linings for strength and seems to provide universal satisfaction when applied to direction.
